## **Board of Directors Meeting**

As a quorum was not present, the October Minutes will be held for approval at our January meeting. The following reports were given but the Board made no decisions.

Report from October 29 Historic Preservation Commission meeting:

- a) 817 North Elm Street – Change in color of approved roofing shingle – Denied.
- b) 1115 Virginia St – Replace shingle siding with new wood shingles – Approved.
- c) 910 Magnolia St – Petition for Determination of Demolition By Neglect – Continued for 60 days so HPC staff can try to contact the owner.

The next HPC meeting is rescheduled to December 10 due to Thanksgiving.

Sonya plans to schedule a Neighborhood Watch meeting in February.

Locations for Elm trees to be planted along Elm Street in the park have been staked. Sally is coordinating this with the Parks & Recreation Department. Robert Kantlehner will coordinate with First Presbyterian to plant the approved plantings along Fisher Park Circle across from the church.

A First Presbyterian Church youth contacted John regarding a green initiative they have started and they want to plant some canopy trees in the park. Robert Kantlehner will work with the church committee to present a proposed plan for review by the Park Committee and a recommendation to the Board.

With regard to the Eugene Street resurfacing, Mike Mabe with the City of Greensboro Field Operations needs to hear from us about the exposed brick gutters. Let him know that we want them to remain exposed. He can be reached at 373-4987.

Election of officers and appointment of committee chairs for 2009 will be done at our January Board meeting.
